This is a **FREE** two-week (Monday-Friday) summer program in which science and math are integrated with field trips in a warm, friendly setting, taught by St. Francis College science professors.

There will be DNA barcoding experiments and activities in our St. Francis College labs as well as field trips to places, such as the American Museum of Natural History, the Brooklyn Botanic Garden, and the New York Aquarium, along with fishing and kayaking in Brooklyn Bridge Park. There will be pizza and an awards ceremony on the last day of the program!
